1. The **Ministry of Tourism, Wildlife and Antiquities** has allocated funds to be used for the acquisition of **External Renovation of the Museum Building and Paving of the Car Park and Drive Way**.
2. The Entity invites sealed bids from eligible bidders for the provision of the above works.
3. Bidding shall be conducted in accordance with the procedures contained in the Public Procurement and Disposal of Public Assets Act, 2003 (the Act) and the Regulations made under the Act and is open to all bidders.
4. Interested eligible bidders may obtain further information and inspect the bidding document at the address given below at 8(a) from **08:00am to 05:00pm**, on working days.
5. The bidding document which has been prepared in the **English language** may be purchased by interested bidders at 8(b) upon payment of a non-refundable fee of **Ugx: 200,000 (Uganda Shillings Two Hundred Thousand Only)**. The method of payment will be **through the Bank**.
6. Bids must be delivered to the address below at 8(c) at or before **10:00am, 22/04/2020**. All bids must be accompanied by a bid security of **Ugx: 12,000,000 (Uganda Shillings Twelve Million Only)**. Bid securities must be valid until **28/07/2020**. Late bids shall be rejected. Bids will be opened in the presence of the bidders' representatives who choose to attend at the address below at 8(d) at **11:00am – 22/04/2020**.
7. There shall be a pre-bid meeting/site visit at **The Uganda Museum at 11:00am** on the dates indicated in the proposed schedule in this notice.
